WOs traditionally wear their badge of rank on the cuff of their right sleeve.

Officers traditionally wear their badge of rank on their shoulders.

Note:

It is now common to see all badges of rank worn on a fabric slide on the chest. A WO2 wears a large crown on his/her chest whereas a Major wears a small crown.
