Cadets are discouraged from bringing expensive clothing, jewellery and personal electronics as they may get lost, damaged or stolen.

Cadets are responsible for the safekeeping and security of their mobile phones, which must be turned off or silent during training.

\* These items can be issued if you require them. Try and bring your own if you can.

<sup>α</sup> A padlock is needed for each cadet's locker. Please clearly label the spare key and hand it into the camp bank for safe keeping – the cadets will inevitably lose their own key!

<sup>β</sup> You must bring sufficient medication for the duration of camp. Please complete and return the medical declaration forms.

<sup>γ</sup> You will need spending money for the visits and for the NAAFI (a recommended amount is £30 per week). Spending money can be paid into the Detachment camp bank for safe keeping. Cadets are reminded of the need to keep their money secure at all times to avoid theft or loss.
