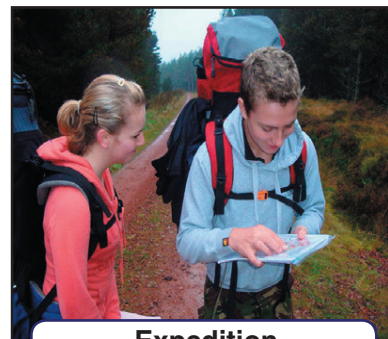




Could you be an adult instructor with Northumbria Army Cadet Force?

No previous military experience is necessary. Our uniformed adults are paid up to 28 days per year and have their travel expenses refunded. Most adults put in extra voluntary days to ensure the cadets get the best possible training experience.



Expedition

Northumbria Army Cadet Force is the voluntary youth organisation of the British Army in your local area. Army cadets follow a progressive system of training called the Army Proficiency Certificate (APC), which aims to improve their skills in a wide range of military, adventurous and community based activities. Most cadet training takes place on weekday evenings, weekends and during our ten day long summer camp, which is near York this year.



Fieldcraft

W Company is responsible for training the cadets in north Northumberland. We have Detachments based in Alnwick, Amble, Belford, Berwick, Broomhill and Rothbury.



First Aid

In addition to their APC training many cadets, and adults are involved with the Duke of Edinburgh's Award and are working towards Vocational Qualifications such as BTEC.

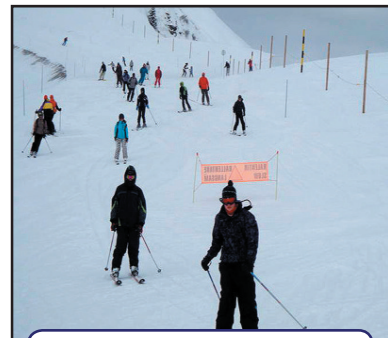

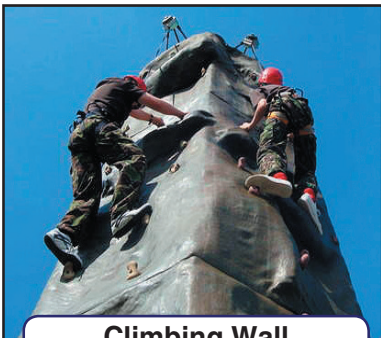

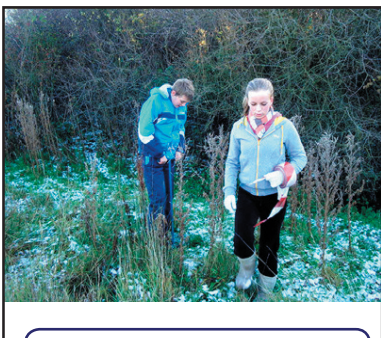
